A few requests from the National Bunraku Theatre



Please take your seat when the 5-minutes to curtain opening bell rings.

Refrain from entering/exiting the hall during performance as much as possible. Depending on the performance currently going on the stage, you may be requested to wait before entering the hall.



Please refrain from bringing large bags into the hall.

Use coin-operated lockers or request assistance from the reception desk.

Set your cell-phone or electronic devices switched off before the performance starts.

Do not forget to turn off the alarm function of the wristwatch or similar devices.



Please place a hearing aid or the earphone guide firmly in your ear.

Lower the volume as much as possible and please turn off the switch when you remove it.



Please observe silence during performance. Refrain from talking or making noises.

Even seemingly small noises such as rustle of plastic bags or tinkling of accessory bells may be quite annoying to others.



Please use the lobby if your young child has difficulty remaining quiet.

Food and drink are not allowed in the hall during performance.

Use the lobby during intermission. If you must eat at your seat, refrain from consuming alcoholic beverages.



Please keep to the seat you have purchased. Do not move to other seats.

Please be mindful of the guests behind you.

Remove wide-brimmed hat if you wear one. Do not overly bend forward during performance.



Taking photographs, using a video cam or other forms of recording devices are strictly forbidden.
